

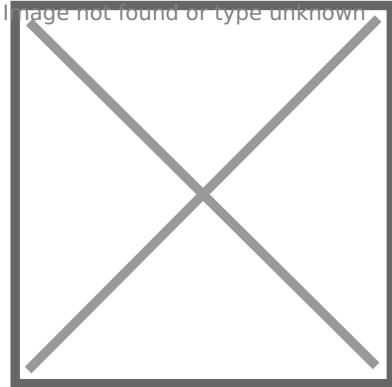
Epicurus' Birthday 2023 - (The Most Comprehensive Picture Yet!)
