Lucretius Was Right: All You Really Need To Know Is In Book 1:



- Nothing comes from nothing, nothing goes to nothing.
- The elements which make up the universe are eternal, but no combination of those elements is eternal.
- Your soul is a combination of elements and not eternal; your life is over when you die, so you must use it while you have it.
- There are no supernatural gods guiding the universe or telling you what to do.
- Religion is the greatest force for evil in the world. Its priests seek to hold you in bondage, but you can free yourself from them through study of nature, and you can rest assured that with death comes total freedom from their threats.
- Unless you trust and use what your senses tell you, you are lost.
- Feeling - Pleasure and Pain – is the Natural force that motivates all living things.

The rest you can figure out for yourself.

And when you apply the principles of Epicurus you'll see that the "history" you were taught in school has nothing to do with "truth," but rather is what the victors in every war leading up to today want you to know. Question not only authority, but question everything. Answers do exist.
