Theism is broadly defined as the belief in the existence of at least one deity.<sup>[1][2]</sup> In common parlance, or when contrasted with deism, the term often describes the classical conception of God that is found in monotheism (also referred to as classical theism) — or gods found in polytheistic religions — a belief in God or in gods without the rejection of revelation as is characteristic of deism.
