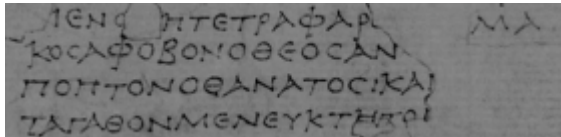


# Diving Deep Into The History of The Tetrpharmakon / Tetrpharmakos
