Not quite μετακόσμος, but we have two instances of μετακοσμέω, *rearrange / modify*:

Great find! I never caught that the verb [μετακοσμέω](#) ("to re-arrange" or "modify") is related to the noun [μετακόσμος](#) ("between-worlds"). This sort of suggests to me that the "space between worlds" would have been perceived as a creative continuum in which re-arrangements of particles occurs.
