Later tradition ascribed to each sage a pithy saying of his own, but ancient as well as modern scholars have doubted the legitimacy of such ascriptions.<sup>[12]</sup> A compilation of 147 maxims, inscribed at Delphi, was preserved by the fifth century CE scholar [Stobaeus](#) as "Sayings of the Seven Sages",<sup>[13]</sup> but "the actual authorship of the ... maxims set up on the Delphian temple may be left uncertain. Most likely they were popular proverbs, which tended later to be attributed to particular sages."<sup>[14]</sup>
