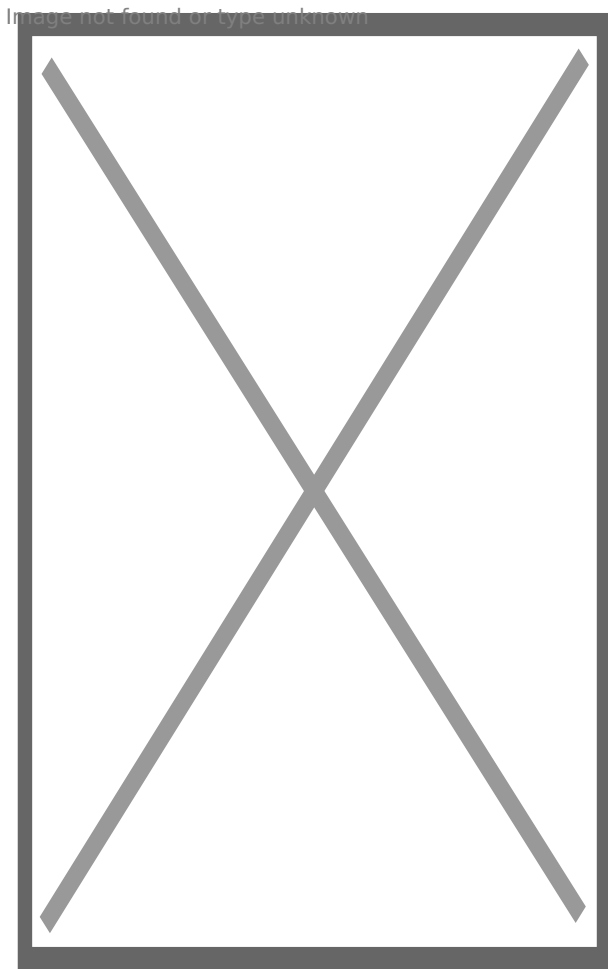


Comparing Cicero's "De Officiis", Thomas Jefferson's "Social Duties", and Epicurean Philosophy
