I used the website, Etsy, which is a collaborative platform that brings independent creators together so you can literally find anything. And you can message the sellers to get things designed how you like.

The creator/ shop I used was called SuedeSentiment.

I saw she had customisable scrolls. So I messaged her about what I was hoping to do , as I wanted that quote. And after some conversations she gave me a custom (Reserved listing) and this was all done within a couple of days. (from start of convo, to around my neck).

The pendant itself isn't expensive, but it's unique, hand crafted, and ideal for myself. Approx \$40AUD in total.

Coming into Aussie summer it'll be in the Bondi Sea and Sand and such.

I liked SuedeSentiment as (first time I have purchased from her) but she was helpful, local to Australia and the pendant measure approx 1.375 Inch so not too long.

If you browse Etsy I'm sure you'll find a creator that can do a design you'd like.

I like the fact it's a one of a kind, inexpensive momento that carries a cool Epicurean message.

If you wanted the same, I'm sure she could craft one again.
