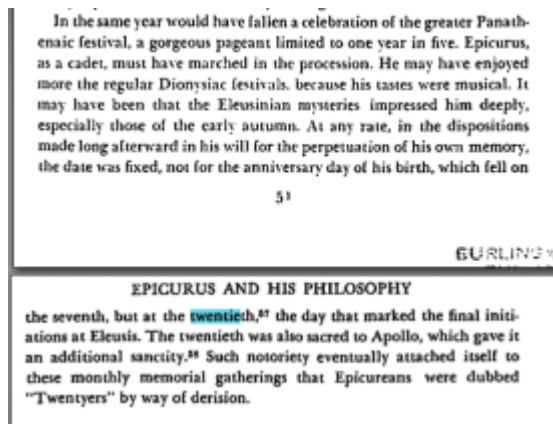
I am trying to come up with a list of names which were applied to the Epicureans either by themselves or others. So far I have:
