

Article that Contains Good Research But Questionable Conclusions About Fear of Premature Death (Kirk Sanders Article)

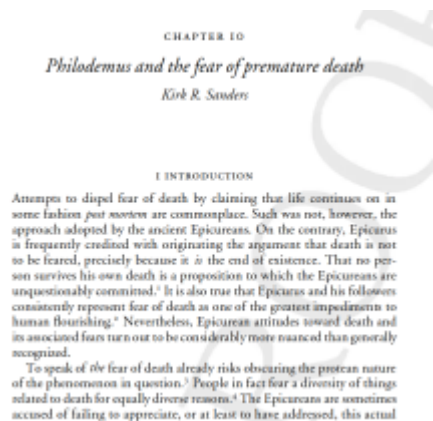
