


CHARALAMPOS PATZOGLOU - "Epicurean Philosophy In Modern Times"

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FEW WORDS ABOUT THE AUTHOR

Mpampis makes his third writing effort in this book. In order to trouble people that are trying to solve their existential problem through theories and practices that have already been tested and rejected by society. His initial guess has become certain that all these theories are the birth of a gruesome gang of subhumans, covered in the darkness of History. Moreover, through a writing, he seeks to orient free people in today's era, which is dominated by parliamentary oligarchy and extreme massification.

Mpampis was born in Athens in May 1955. He lives and works in Nea Ionia, Attica, Greece. He has been self made under adverse conditions which, it should be noted, are similar to those prevailing today. He's a graduate of the Piraeus University of Economics, but he's more interested in Classical Letters. Among other things, he also worked in the municipal Library of Nea Ionia, as a librarian, from which he was persecuted because he had no party identity. At the same time he was a member of a small, free and informal philosophical group of friends, away from parties and factions. A philosophical group that was concerned with finding the purpose of Nature and Man by giving the value that Man keeps in Nature. In this philosophical group, conclusions have been drawn concerning every minded person and being similar to Epicurean Philosophy. He then worked in public for 25 years and resigned when he had the honorary position of a supervisor. In addition, he is one of the founding members of the philosophical society "Friends of Epicurean Philosophy, Garden". Nevertheless, starting his systematic writing work in 2005, he has written eight books and
