No precise date can be assigned to the original statue of Epicurus because, as is usually the case with Greek portraits, neither the original nor any Hellenistic copies survive. A *terminus ante quem* may, however, be provided by the "Epikou-ro[s]" inscription on what was probably once the shaft of a herm of Epicurus in Old Paphos.¹⁰⁰ According to Mitford, the lettering of the inscription is datable to the period 250–200 B.C. Assuming that there must have been a lapse of some
