could not possibly have done so. Before 1742, when the Epicurus-Metrodorus double herm with ancient identifying inscription (figure 12) was discovered beneath the new porch of S. Maria Maggiore in Rome (the herm is now in the Capitoline Museum),⁶⁰ Epicurus' true image was not known.⁵⁹
