

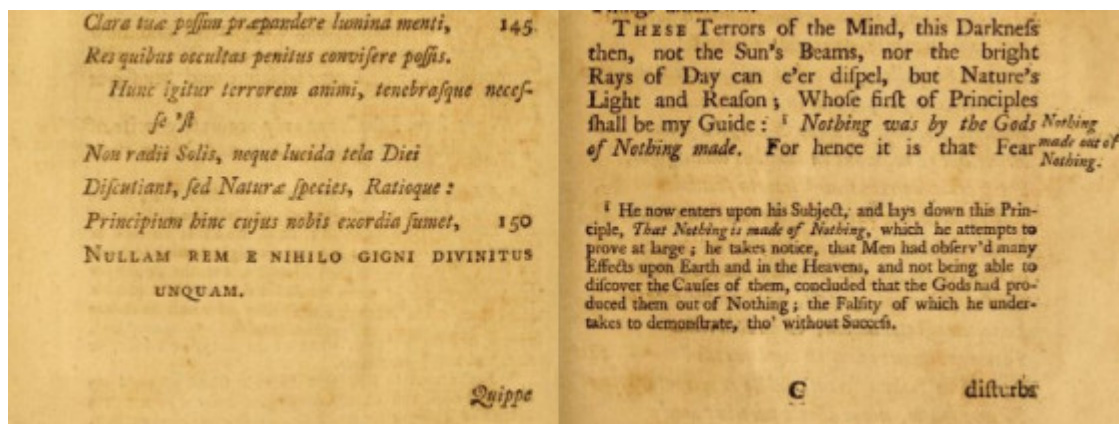
Happy Twentieth of May: Don't Surrender - Instead Retreat, Regroup, Advance!
