FYI when you're agonizing over boundless vs infinite vs incomprehensible number in "verse" 42/43 seems kind of moot in that the word used in Greek that appears to be used in all places in the text is ἄπειρος "boundless," literally from ἀ- (a-, "not") + πείραρ (peîrar), πέρας (péras, "end, limit") :

The "not comprehensible" is simply οὐχ ἄπειροι "not apeiroi"
