What we eventually need is a "vector graphic" image of that leaping pig, along the lines of what Nate already has, in a format that these vector graphic programs like Inkscape (the free one) and others can use.

That way the image can be rotated and resized and all sorts of things done to it without losing sharpness.

I think what's involved is "tracing" the PNG into such a program and saving it in SVG format. I will try to experiment if I can find time, but that's what we need - an SVG format.

Ironic, because what it means is turning an actual image of a pig into a series of electronic numbers 😊
