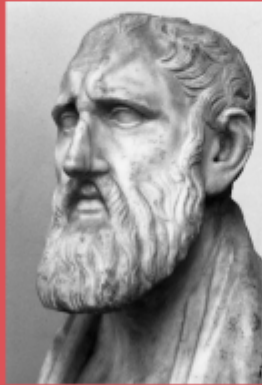
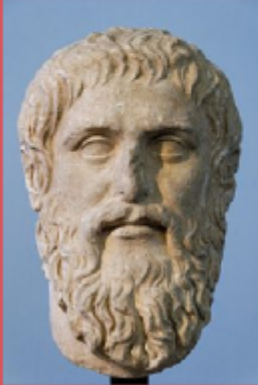


The Nature of The Soul As Perishing At Death
