

# What if Kyriai Doxai was NOT a list?

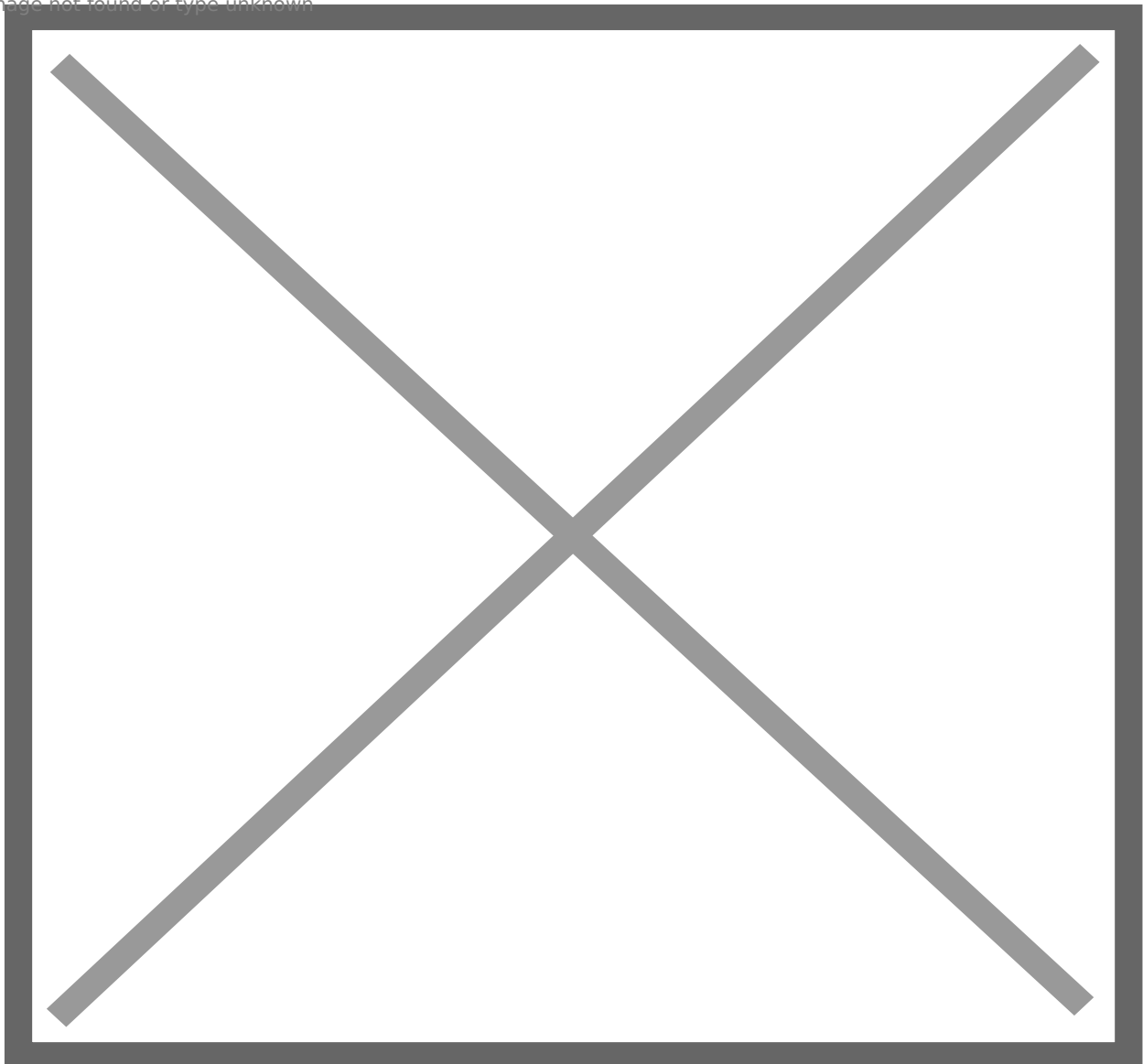
