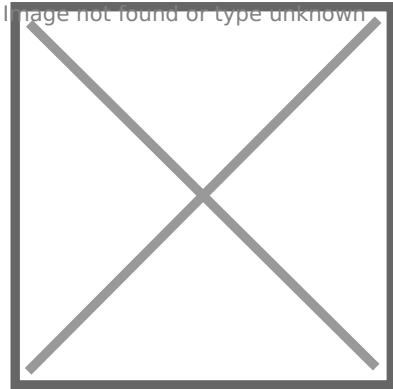

I also continue to think that it could have something to do with adherence to the Law which Paul doesn't think brings salvation (hence it is "weak" and "beggarly"). But I don't think his wording allows for an Epicurean take on the "elements" in any way... At least not at this time.
