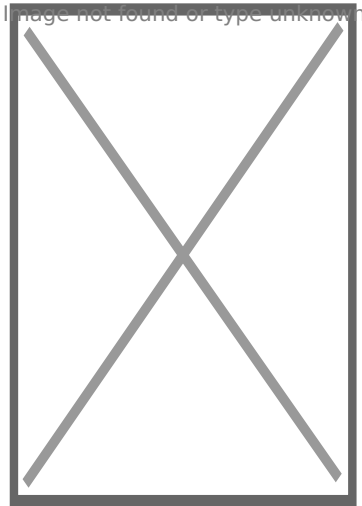


Papyrus Oxyrhynchus 215
