

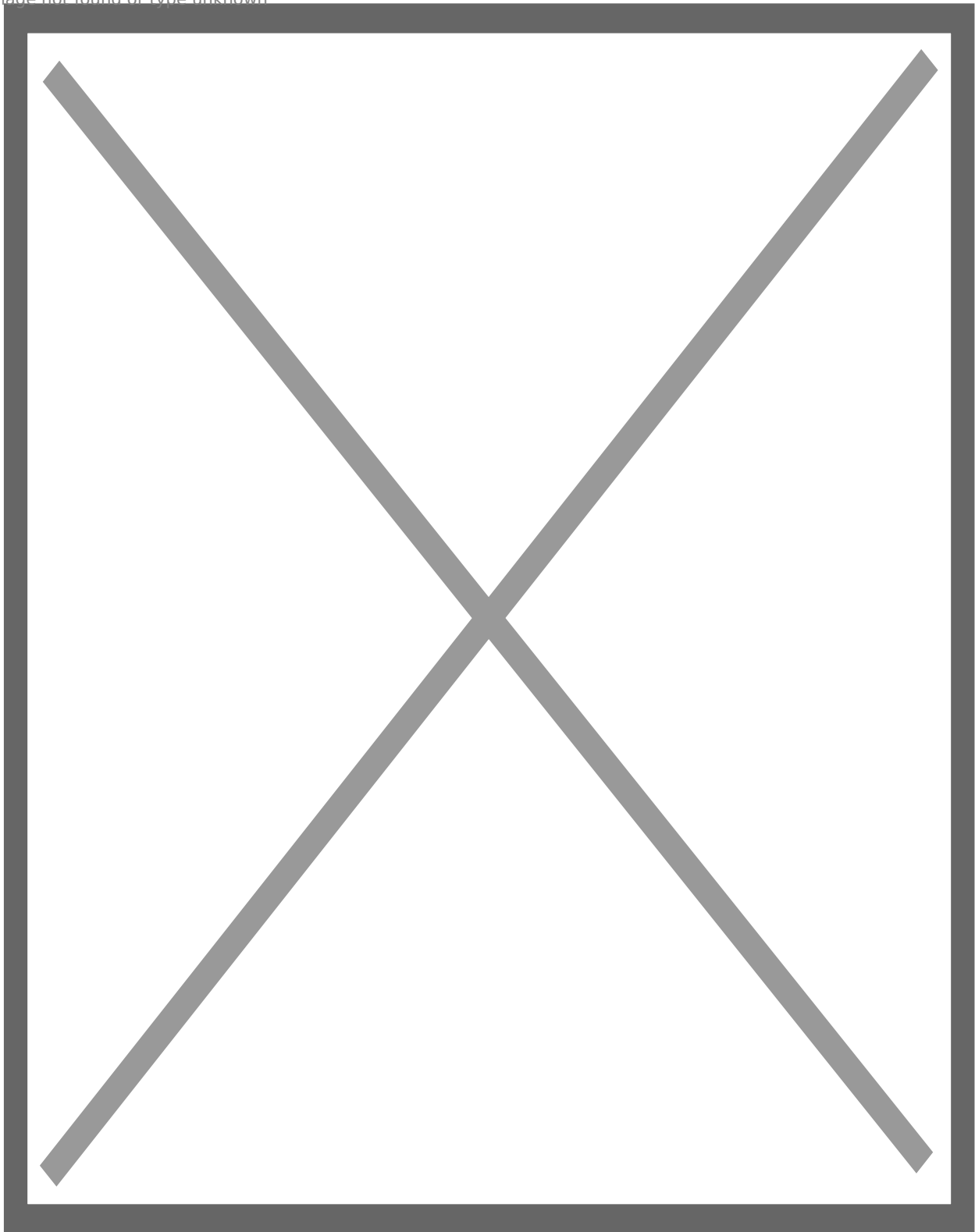
Episode 250 - Cicero's OTNOTG 25: The Relationship of "Images" To All Human Thought - Not Just To "The Gods"

For the Latin scholars, who can opine on which of the three is most authentic or appropriate, I suppose this is our sestercentennial / semiquincentennial / bisesquicentennial episode!

The **United States Semiquincentennial**,^[a] also called the **Bisesquicentennial**, the **Sestercentennial** or the **Quarter Millennial**, will be the 250th anniversary of the 1776 [United States Declaration of Independence](#). Festivities will be scheduled to mark various events leading up to the anniversary on July 4, 2026.

Also: 250 years. Sestercentennial. To express $2\frac{1}{2}$ in Latin it would be expressed as "half-three". The term relates to being **halfway [from the second] to the third integer**. In Latin this is "Sestertius", which is a contraction of semis (halfway) tertius (third)—hence Sestercentennial.
