

The Absence of Sin

In the Sayings of the Wise (10.120), Epíkouros employs the word ἀμάρτημα (*amártēma*) meaning "mistakes", "failures", "faults" "guilts", "flaws" "errors", or "sins". This corresponds with several employments of αμαρτία (*amartía*) and ἀμαρτάνω (*amartánō*, meaning "to miss", "to fail to correctly aim", "to lose", "to fail", "to sin") throughout Paul's Epistles in the New Testament.

I bet we'll find more examples.
