But if it is not a good for everyone, it is an evil to some and indifferent to others. But I say that it is neither absolutely a good nor an evil nor something indifferent; nor, by analogy, is wealth. Others have different opinions . . . (. . . την πενίαν . . . αγαθὸν [καθόλου] ἢ κακὸν ὀρθῶς [ἂν τις ἔλεγε]· εἰ δ' οὐ πᾶσιν ἔστιν ἀγαθόν], ἀλλ' ἐνίοις καὶ κακόν, τισιν
