

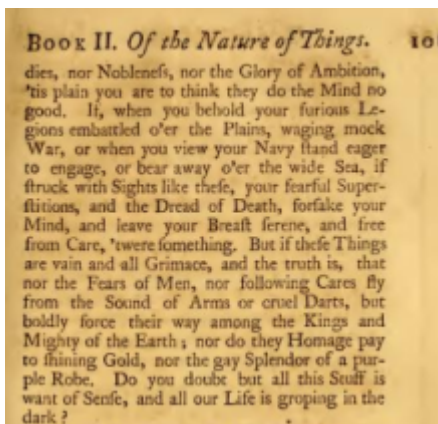
Background and Analysis: "Roman Poets of the Republic" by William Sellar (1881)
