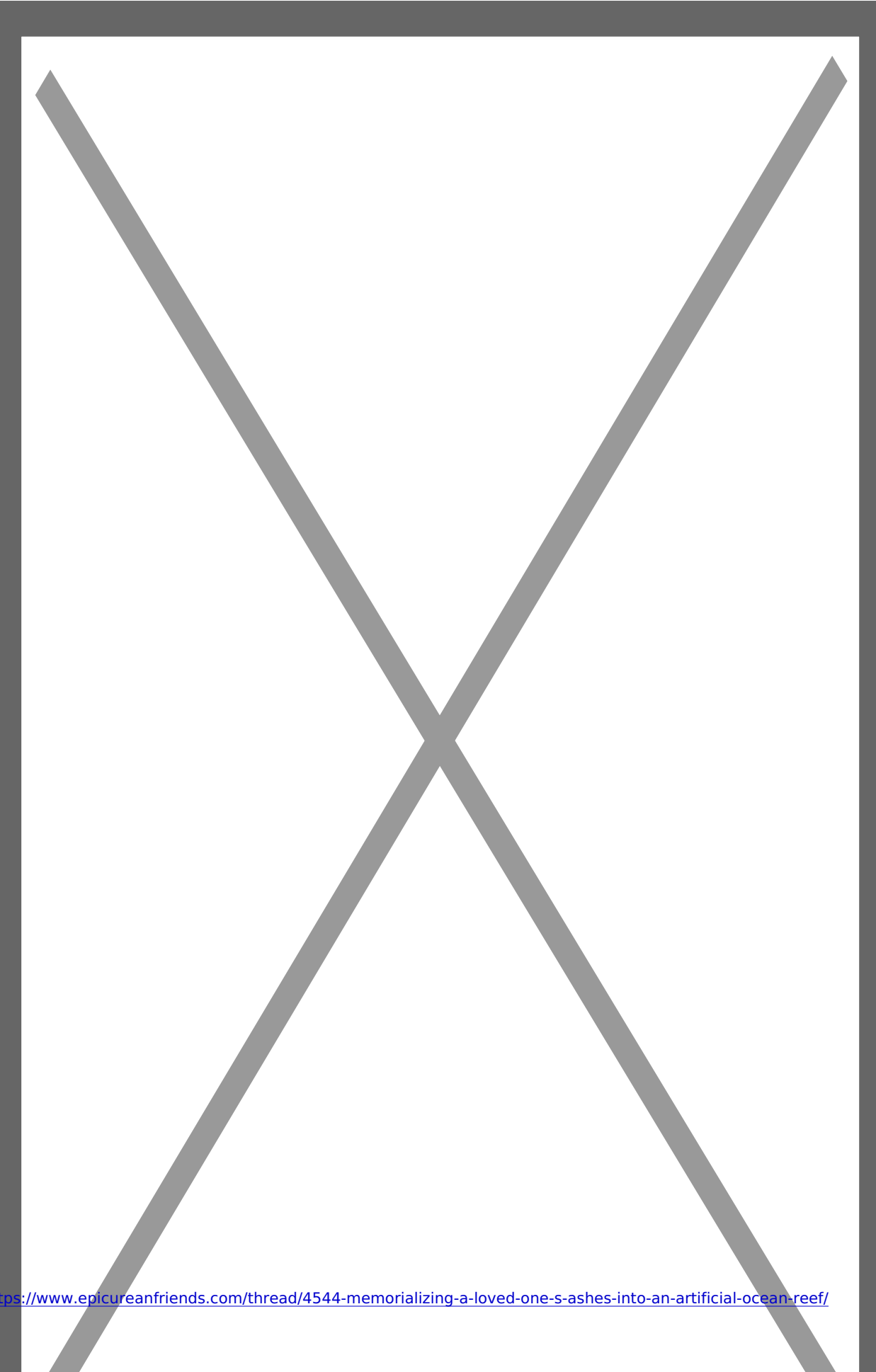


Memorializing a loved one's ashes into an artificial ocean reef
